Sheriff Report	-Sheriff Marston reviewed current template for handheld radios. Currently we are using only LEO channels. Eventually there will be 3 consoles in Dispatch. Marston is proposing changes to possibly include: moving equipment / tower to one of the water towers. Cost to be around \$10,000. (Only portable radios were discussed.) The cost of the new template would be \$50 per radio if done by Motorola. It is possible that 911 monies might be available for the upgrade. All handheld and mobile units should have a laminated template available. - Having two dispatchers will lower the ISO rating and other concerns. (For every point lowered in the ISO, there is a 15-20% savings discount.)
