Members from ECMS and EMS will demonstrate kit usage at the high school. Ms. Ranker taught everyone how to save a life tonight. First ensure your own safety. If you become injured, you will not be able to help the victim. Then call 9-1-1 or ask someone to call 9-1-1. Find the source of bleeding by exposing the wound. Apply pressure by pushing directly on the wound. For life threatening bleeding from an arm or leg use a tourniquet. Everyone was then given a chance to apply a tourniquet on the dummy arm or a live volunteer.
