

## ELLSWORTH COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

### MINUTES

**February 6, 2017**

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 6<sup>th</sup> day of February 2017 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

**OPENING BUSINESS:**

Chairman Oller called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the Agenda. Commissioner Oller seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Oller moved to approve the Minutes of January 30, 2017. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

**OPEN FORUM:**

**Billy Kryger**, Pastor of the Smoky Hill Baptist Church in Ellsworth, was in attendance but did not wish to address the Commissioners.

**APPOINTMENTS:**

**Teresa Shute, Noxious Weed & Landfill Supervisor**, informed the Commissioners of the fire at the Landfill that got out of control last Thursday, February 2, 2017. She was grateful that the fire did not hurt anything or anyone.

**Paul Kasper, County Attorney**, asked to contribute \$250.00 to each of the three in County School proms. He said that his diversion fund had brought in roughly \$1,000.00 since taking office as County Attorney. Commissioner Dlabal made the motion to donate \$250.00 to USD 327, USD 112 and Wilson after prom. Commissioner Oller seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

**Murray Marston, County Sheriff**, received reports on the black mold in the basement of the Sheriff's office. The Commissioners asked if he could get two bids on cleaning the basement. Sheriff Marston said he had figured an average per inmate meal was \$2.78 last year. He can contract with the Prison and Aramark to receive inmate meals for \$1.52 to \$1.75 per meal.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the 2017 Kanas County Commissioner Association Membership Dues. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rush made a motion to approve abatements 2016, 32 and 33 for a total of \$593.32. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
